Correspondence

- Funding Requests – the P&C received a huge amount of funding requests from teachers and staff for upgrading the school community.
- VHS Basketball Courts – complete rebuild of courts, requesting partial funding - \$50,000
- MTB School Jerseys – 40 new school-owned MTB Jerseys - \$1,680
- Support Unit “Brain Breaks” – purchase of 2 new exercise bikes - \$898
- Support Unit Sun Shade – over grassed area - \$3,000
- Support Unit Life Skills Cooking – purchase of 3 x Bench top ovens and 3 x Kitchen Trolleys - \$905.97
- Aboriginal Education – Outdoor Learning Area – expanding on our Yarning Circle - \$2,000
- Dance KLA PDHPE – Southern Stars Dance Team - \$4,000
- Dance KLA PDHPE – VHS Dance Teams - \$3,000
- TAS/HSIE/PE – Booderee Bush Blitz - \$1,500
- TAS – beautification of gardens in TAS area and shelter - \$3,000
- Mathematics – Collaborative Learning Space – new furniture that assists with collaborative learning - \$30,000
- TAS – Ipad & pencils for computer aided design projects - \$6,980
- English/Drama – upgrade of Performance Space - \$2,553

General Business

- Pastoral Care Position – Ruth advised the P&C that Ulladulla P&C are helping with the management of this position. Ulladulla wanted to see our canteen and how it is run and they have helped with the Pastoral Care position.
- Bus for Support Unit – Liz advised we don't fit into any criteria for state or federal funding for a support bus. Clubs at the moment are not wanting to sell or upgrade any buses due to Covid. This is something the support unit really needs so they are not relying on the Havenlee Bus and it is costing a fortune to hire the bus also. Variety was approached but a warm welcome was not received as the bus is not being used primarily for the support unit. The P&C agrees we would like to help but would rather contribute to a new bus if Variety could support also. Meaghan will approach Variety again and open communication lines and P&C will earmark \$40,000 towards this once more information is forthcoming. Motion moved by Nina; seconded by Jenny.
