Preliminary Geography focuses on the biophysical interactions which make our planet unique. We focus on Ecosystems at Risk, Urban Places, and People & Economic activity. We look at contemporary global geographical issues such as Tourism, Megacities, and The Great Barrier Reef. to identify and analyse management strategies that are implemented to ensure ecological sustainability. In this course, you will study case studies such as the Murray Darling River basin (local) and the Mekong Delta River (global) to understand the social, political, economic, and environmental issues that occur when humans interact with the natural world.
