

HSC Disability Provisions.

Reasonable adjustments for students with disabilities so that they can access and participate in the HSC with equity.

About the Course

Disability Provisions address students' exam needs related to learning, medical, vision, or hearing disabilities. For example students with a learning disability may use a reader or writer; those with a medical disability may access toilet breaks; those with a vision disability may use braille or large print papers, and those with hearing disability may use an oral or sign interpreter. Applying for HSC Disability Provisions

Schools are responsible for submitting Disability Provision applications. At Vincentia High School the applications are made by the Learning and Support Team. Please contact the Head Teacher Learning and Support to discuss the supports you require. We can start these conversations in Year 11.

Disability provisions are one way that NESA ensures there are reasonable adjustments available to students with disability so that they can access and participate in the HSC on the same basis as students without disability.
