You will undertake two preliminary textile projects. Project 1 focuses on the generation and communication of ideas, design modification, manipulative skills, evaluation of ideas and the project, and management of time and resources. Project 2 is focused on an analysis of fabric, yarn, and fiber properties, experimental procedures, product design, fabric choice, manipulative and management skills, communication methods, and the recording of information.
