Students who intend to undertake work experience in the construction area must obtain their **WHITE CARD** beforehand. This is a requirement under Safe Work NSW and the Work Health and Safety Act 2011. Jobs in this category would include: Building trades, landscaping, surveying, some maintenance work, and installation of air conditioners, security systems, fire sprinklers, fire doors and glass. Installation of vertical blinds, fencing and construction of dams.

New Program: Steps 2 Success!

The new Steps to Success Program is funded by the Department of Industry & Training Services NSW and is coordinated by Workplace Learning Nowra. The objective of the Program is to assist and mentor Year 10 or 11 students across schools in the Illawarra and Shoalhaven to pursue pathways which lead to them gaining a job, particularly apprenticeships or traineeships, or to pursue further studies. The key elements of the Program are:

Career planning – your individual skills, interests and abilities will be assessed to provide a personalised career profile;

Smart and Skilled – based on your career profile you will be enrolled in Certificate II or III Vocational Education Training part qualification;

Job preparation – a series of workshops will help you with your a resume, applying for a job, going for an interview and understanding the workplace; and

On the job experience – spending a week getting hands-on experience doing the job identified through your career profile.

Students Based Apprenticeships or Traineeships (SBATS)

SBATS: “are available to all Year 10, 11 and 12 high school students in NSW. They allow students to commence an apprenticeship or complete a traineeship while at school. A School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship combines paid work, training and school; and an industry recognised national qualification that will gain credit towards the HSC. Some apprenticeships and traineeships can contribute towards the ATAR” (<https://sbatinnsw.info/>).

- To engage students in meaningful educational experiences
