Today the school held a formal assembly to celebrate the teaching career of our Principal, Mr Steve Glenday.

When Mr Glenday officially retires on January 28, 2018 he will have worked 39 years for the Department of Education. Since 2005, when he became the Principal at Vincentia High School, he has overseen the education of more than 6,000 students!

The surprise assembly began with a Welcome to Country by Kiana Ashby and the National Anthem sung by Harmony Dyer. Items performed at the assembly included a tribute by Mrs Higgins and Miss Keogh, a dance performance, a rousing rendition of the chicken dance, a humorous film titled 'A day in the life of Mr Glenday', an interview by a chicken and a Dance n' Didj performance.





The School Captains farewelled Mr Glenday and wished him a relaxing and

well deserved retirement, he was then presented with a timber teppanyaki table as a gift from the students. After the assembly the whole school moved to the oval to form the words 'Farewell Mr Glenday' which was captured for prosperity by Daryl Head with his drone.

All students were invited to enjoy a slice of cake distributed by our wonderful TAS department. Mr Glenday's last day at school will be Friday 10 November.





### Gifted & Talented Workshops with the Bundanon Trust

Last week, forty gifted and talented students across years 7 to 11 participated in a collaborative faculty workshop in conjunction with the Bundanon Trust. Guided by three animators from the Trust, Mrs Ryder, Mrs Hudman and Mr Volpatti worked with the students form Visual Arts, Photography, Design &Technology and Woodwork classes to design and construct a Zoetrope.

A Zoetrope is a pre film animation device that produces the illusion of motion. It is cylinder-shaped with a sequence of pictures on its inner surface which, when viewed through the vertical slits spaced regularly around it while the cylinder is spinning, produce

an illusion of animation. Students and staff enjoyed working together and learning new skills.
