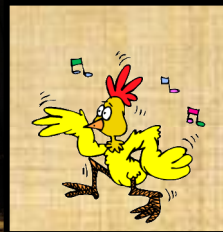

All students were invited to enjoy a slice of cake distributed by our wonderful TAS department. Mr Glenday's last day at school will be Friday 10 November.







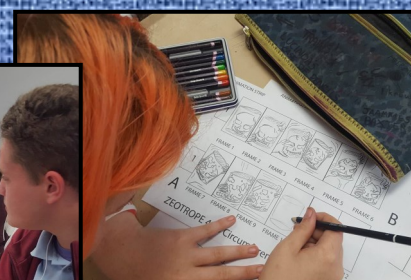
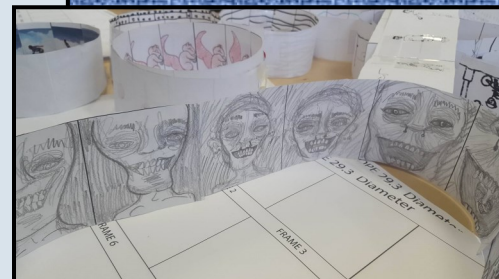




# Gifted & Talented Workshops with the Bundanon Trust

Last week, forty gifted and talented students across years 7 to 11 participated in a collaborative faculty workshop in conjunction with the Bundanon Trust. Guided by three animators from the Trust, Mrs Ryder, Mrs Hudman and Mr Volpatti worked with the students from Visual Arts, Photography, Design & Technology and Woodwork classes to design and construct a Zoetrope.

A Zoetrope is a pre film animation device that produces the illusion of motion. It is cylinder-shaped with a sequence of pictures on its inner surface which, when viewed through the vertical slits spaced regularly around it while the cylinder is spinning, produce an illusion of animation. Students and staff enjoyed working together and learning new skills.


